| Pinot Grigio Blush Rechsteiner (Italy) 12.0% | 175ml 6.5 | 250ml 9 | 26 |
| <i>Crisp, refreshing delicacy from the Pinot Grigio grape. A fruity nose, full of finesse, exudes aromas of yellow apple, pear and fragrant spring flowers, before more fruit is revealed on a medium-bodied palate.</i> | | | |

| <i>Berry flavours in abundance but the sweetness is balanced in this easy drinking Rosé.</i> | | | |

| <i>Light in body and extremely good to glug with lashings of cherry fruit.</i> | | | |

| <i>Quintessential, lightly oaked, non offensive, well made Shiraz. Not too much tannin and bags of uncomplicated Shiraz fruit.</i> | | | |
| Adrian Serrano Rioja Crianza (Spain) 14.2% | 175ml 6.8 | 250ml 9.6 | 29 |
| <i>A Crianza that's aged for 16 months in American oak giving a vanilla aspect to the lightly spicy cherry fruit. Light in style and easy to drink but also essentially a good food wine.</i> | | | |
| Primitivo Tacco Barocco, Cantina Sampietrana (Italy) | | | 31 |
| <i>Aged for 9-12 months in barriques this is a rich raisiny beast with hints of liquorice and citrus.</i> | | | |
| Don David Malbec Reserve (Argentina) | | | 38 |
| <i>Generous fruit and spice with well integrated soft tannins, and a rounded, lingering finish.</i> | | | |
| Ripasso Valpolicella, Montresor (Italy) | | | 40 |
| <i>A warm, inviting, richly fruity nose, with aromas of fresh morello cherry, ripe plum and hints of dried fruits. The palate is similarly full-flavoured with concentrated, crunchy black cherry, brown spice and vanilla notes and a hint of liquorice.</i> | | | |

| <i>Intense cherry red colour with hints of ruby that displays ripe red fruit with mineral and toasted nuances from the oak ageing. An elegant palate with a good balance between the fruit and oak.</i> | | | |

| <i>Plenty of warm, roasty, sweetish fruit from a blend of principally Grenache with Syrah and Cinsault. A bright ruby colour. Toasted, furry, brothy and undergrowth nose. Ripe tannins are assorted with ripe black cherry on the palate.</i> | | | |

| <i>Powerful and sophisticated with incredible depth of fruit and velvety texture.</i> | | | |

| <i>Ripe, warm and generous on the nose with plum and cherry aromas and hints of dried fruits. Full bodied and richly flavoured with rich berry and plum fruit, supple tannins.</i> | | | |

| <i>Intense cherry-red color with maroon rim. Generous aroma in which ripe fruit combines harmoniously with vanilla and liquorice. The palate is ample, full, round, fleshy. Long stately finish.</i> | | | |
